



PE/ Sports premium

The PE and Sport Premium Grant is paid to all schools and academies with primary-age pupils to enable them to make additional and sustainable improvements to the quality of their PE and sport. The funding is also aimed at encouraging pupils in their development of healthy and active lifestyles.

Payment of the Grant is made by the Education Skills and Funding Agency (ESFA) and in the case of our own academy, funding is based on the number of KS2 pupils that we had on role in the January 2017 census. The Grant is paid in 2 separate payments namely:

- 7/12 funding allocation November 2017
- 5/12 funding allocation May 2018

At Olive AP Academy Suffolk (Central) we received **£2000** during this academic year (17-18) in PE – Sports Premium Grant. We have used this money to increase the curriculum PE offer at our academy, with the funding of an Instructor for one day per week from the latter end of the autumn term onwards. We also used the funding received to buy into membership of the National Association for Physical Education, giving access to a wealth of sports and PE coaching knowledge.

The impact of the funding from the PE-Sports Premium Grant has been:

- Reduction in Level 1 & 2 behaviours
- Improved gross motor skills
- Improved understanding of a healthy lifestyle
