



Year 7 Catch Up funding

The literacy and numeracy catch-up premium is given to all state-funded schools, including special schools and alternative provision settings, as additional funding to support year 7 pupils who did not achieve the DFE expected standard in reading or maths at the end of key stage 2 (KS2).

In 2017 to 2018 funding was allocated by the DFE on the same basis as the previous year but adjusted to reflect any percentage changes in the size of the Year 7 cohort, between the October 2016 and the October 2017 school censuses.

At Olive AP Academy - Suffolk (Central) during the academic year 17-18 we received a Year 7 Catch Up Grant of £500 which was funded as follows

2016 Census recorded 1 Year 7 pupil

2017 Census recorded 5 Year 7 pupils

= 1 pupil / 5 pupils x 2016 -17 Grant Allocation of £100

= £500 Total Yr 7 Catch Up Funding 2017-18

We have used the Catch Up Grant Funding to support one to one interventions for our Yr 7 pupils with the aim of narrowing the gap in their literacy and numeracy progress and attainment levels.
